

STUDENT HANDOUT: SYNONYMS

A **synonym** is a word that has a similar or the same meaning to another word. It is used to replace an existing word which you do not want to repeat.

For example: He **said** 'get the table ready', then he <said> **stated**, "it is soup for tea".

Dictionaries are used to find meanings and to check spellings of words.

We use a **thesaurus** to help identify synonyms. Using a thesaurus can help develop our vocabulary and make writing more interesting.

You can right click on a word in Microsoft Word to find its synonym.
